



2010 Central Ohio Youth Baseball League Fact Sheet

2010 League Registration and fees due by 12-12-09

- **The 2010 season will be sanctioned by at least five sanctioning bodies. Nations Baseball, NABF, Sandlott Baseball, Game Day and CABA Baseball Organizations.**
- Our league is comprised mostly of teams in the Central Ohio area but some teams may be as far as an hour to one and a half hours drive away due to a lack of leagues in the outlying areas.
- Divisions are made taking the strength of the teams into consideration as well as the geographic areas when possible.
- **We will have three classes of play.** The criteria that we start with are as follows:
 - **Select Division:- This division is supposed to be just a step above Recreation ball.**
90% of the players should be from one High School District.
Just because you have 90% of your players from one school does not guarantee a spot at this level.
Strength of team is the ultimate deciding factor.
 - **Elite Division: – At least 75% from one High School District – Primarily a community based team**
 - **Premier Division: – Strong recruited teams**
Note: The School District that we use is the High School District that the player resides in, even if they go to a parochial school.
 - **These are guidelines only and some consideration will be given to small districts.
The Ultimate deciding factor for final classification will be the strength of the team.**
- You can qualify for State and World Series right out of league play. We will also have qualifying tournaments for Nations Baseball and CABA National Tournaments.
- Age cutoffs for 2010 will be April 30th.
- High school divisions have a grade exception rule based on one age up. For example, a 16-year old freshman can play in the 15U - Freshman age division—but not a 17-year old.
- Teams schedule all of their games with the other coaches and also hire umpires for their home games.
- A complete list of licensed umpires will be published on our site as soon as I get the 2010 list. Umpires are also listed on our web site under Umpire Post.
- **League scheduling meetings TBA – mid-January is the target date.**
 - **Watch the web site for location updates and exact times and sites for your age group.**

 - **You must have a representative attend the league meeting**
- We have no bat restrictions other than a maximum of 2 ¾” until U15 and at U15 and above, using the -3 factor just as in High School.

- Divisions will be emailed to the teams in early January.

Once I receive your forms and fees, I will send your info to Nations Baseball and they will setup your team in the system and you will get your user name and password emailed to you unless you are a returning coach and your login info will be the same as 2009.

2009 COYBL LEAGUE FEE STRUCTURE:

- **Option # 1**

LEAGUE FEE TO INCLUDE SANCTIONING WITH ALL 5 NATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS AND TEAM INSURANCE INCLUDED:

Coverage to go into effect 1/1/2010 to 7/31/2010 (7 months coverage) : **\$400.00**

The insurance in option #1 will cover your team at any team function, your umpires and coaches

- **Option # 2**

If you want to register now with insurance coverage from now until 7/31/2010 (Full year of Coverage) : **\$415**

- **Option # 3**

If you want to register now with insurance coverage from January 1st, 2010 to December 31st, 2010 : **\$415**
Full 12 months of coverage

- **Option #4**

LEAGUE FEE TO INCLUDE SANCTIONING WITH ALL 5 NATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS ONLY DOES NOT INCLUDE TEAM INSURANCE ; **\$340**

If you elect Option # 4 with no insurance coverage, You must provide proof of insurance by submitting a PDF of the coverage to Nations Baseball with Nations Baseball, LLC and Central Ohio Youth Baseball, LLCL as additional Insured

Divisions are typically 8-10 teams.

League play begins in the Spring. Some younger teams will start play in April.

League play will end in Mid July. Actual date will be set at the league meeting in January.

All rosters must be on line at www.nations-baseball.com before you play your 1st league game. Please do this ASAP after you receive your email that your team is registered with Nations.
